AN INTEGRATED FRAMEWORK

There are numerous models and approaches for trauma. The field has evolved to acknowledge that trauma can impact all areas of functioning inclusive of cognitions, emotions, behaviours and physical or bodily sensations. The framework incorporates a three-phased model of treatment: safety and stabilization, resolution and integration of the trauma, and closure/moving on. This assessment driven treatment framework is compatible with a multitude of approaches and intervention strategies.

Our ultimate aim is to increase the capacity of competent professionals who can:

Understand the impact of trauma from a developmental perspective and adapt trauma-informed interventions within an integrated framework
